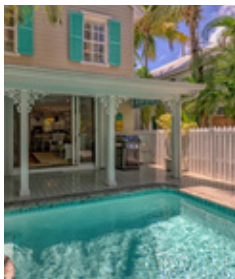


THE GOODYEAR BLIMP
